



January 5th: Adults will reflect on God bringing light to the darkness and ways they can reflect the light of Christ. (John 1:(1-9) 10-18)


January 12th: Adults will explore the baptism of Jesus and reaffirm their own baptismal identity and purpose. (Matthew 3:13-17)

the first Sunday of every month.


